GENERAL PARADE RULES AND INFORMATION

Parade line-up:Noon, Lake Upper Broadway (Village streets close at Noon sharp).

- 1) PLEASE NO LOUD MUSIC OR OTHER AMPLIFIED NOISE DURING LINE UP; PARTICIPANTS NEED TO BE ABLE TO HEAR INSTRUCTIONS FROM PARADE OFFICIALS.
- 2) Unit numbers may be picked up at the Nice N' Easy Mobil, 173 Broadway from 11 AM until Noon on parade day.
 - a) Unit numbers must be displayed on the right front of each unit so the judges can see them.
- 3) All parade entrants will participate in the spirit of civility and good taste.
 - a) The Parade will not be used as a platform for any political or special interests.
 - b) No entry will be entered into the parade who campaigns for any office, promotes any partisan political position or ballot proposal.
 - c) No participant may advocate, oppose, or depict any political, religious, social, or other ballot or political issue or candidate. Elected officials will march as a group.
- 4) Floats and vehicles are limited to 12' height.
- 5) NO alcoholic beverages are allowed.
- 6) Real weapons / projectiles are not allowed.
- 7) Any confetti or other material dispersed on the parade route must be water soluble.
- 8) Any float, car, or walking unit not behaving in a proper manner will be asked to leave the parade.
- 9) Performers must maintain predominantly forward movement.
- 10) Please hold your performances until the parade starts at the Nice N' Easy Mobil station to avoid gaps.
- 11) Your final performance must be done in front of the Judge's stand at the Town Hall.
- 12) At the parade finish, all units need to turn right onto the LaPan Highway (Rt. 3).

Awards will be available after the band concert held in the Harrietstown Town Hall.
